The New Haven Paint and Clay Club was founded sixty one years ago. It is most fitting to open our sixtieth exhibition in a new art center which was bequeathed to the people of New Haven through the very generous gift of our greatly esteemed member, the late Grace Taylor Ely. The building will be known as the John Slade Ely House, in memory of Mrs. Ely's husband, a distinguished physician who served for many years at the Yale School of Medicine. As a center, it will be used by "such groups in New Haven and vicinity, as in the discretion of the trustees, will make the best use of it for exhibiting works of art, holding art classes, lectures and recitals."

After many years of hiring public rooms here and there, more or less on sufferance, New England's oldest art association now claims a more worthy place for exhibits, rent free on the ground floor.

We are indeed grateful to our very generous and public spirited benefactor, the late Mrs. Ely, and also to the trustees of the Ely Estate who have done such fine work in renovating and transforming the first floor for use as a gallery.

OUR ENDOWMENT FUND was established in 1929. Its income is spent by the Executive Committee to purchase works of art from the Annual Exhibition. All works thus acquired are added to the Permanent Collection.

THE CLUB'S PERMANENT COLLECTION is giving satisfaction and pleasure to patients, staff and visitors of the Grace-New Haven and St. Raphael's Hospitals, where an important part of it is on loan. Other pictures are on view in the Chamber of Commerce Auditorium and its hallway.

THE PAINT AND CLAY CLUB renders a notable public service to New Haven. Non-exhibiting membership privileges are open to all who wish to share in this work: Associate Membership, two dollars a year; Sustaining Membership, five dollars a year. Patron Membership is a donation of ten dollars or more a year. Life Membership is one hundred dollars.

ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP: Artists working in any medium, whose work has been exhibited three times in the Club's juried annual exhibitions, are thereby eligible and are invited by the Secretary to Active Membership. Dues are three dollars a year.
